The fee includes all materials, WSET study pack and exam, unit specific revision sessions, ISO tasting glasses and spittoons. Students will need to bring a cloth to dry their glasses after washing between tastings, pens and notepad. The full programme will be issued with the final directions a week before the course starts, but will cover the following topics:

- Tasting technique and food and wine matching
- Wine service and storage
- Grape growing and wine-making
- The major grape varieties and their interpretation around the world
- The wines of France
- German wines
- Wines of Italy, Spain and Portugal
- Wines of the Americas and Southern Hemisphere
- Sparkling wines
- Fortified wines and Dessert wines

These are covered in the eight separate modules that make up the course. We work as a team and you will have the benefit of at least four experienced tutors to illuminate their particular subject areas.

Conditions

The West of England Wine School reserves the right to cancel courses if student numbers are below the minimum of 8 students, however, we try to run courses if we possibly can. In the rare event of a course being cancelled, we will arrange to transfer students to another course if possible. If we cannot do this, the full fee is refunded immediately.

Should a candidate have to cancel at short notice, our cancellation terms are:

Up to 28 days before start of course 100% refund

Up to 14 days before start of course 50% refund

Up to 7 days before start of course 25% refund

Cancellations within 7 days are not refunded. However, in the case of last minute cancellations, we will endeavour to transfer a student to another of our courses if possible.
